Dear guests with dogs,

We are delighted that you are interested in spending your holiday with us.

We want both you and your four-legged companion to feel completely at home in our hotel. Please understand that we kindly ask you to adhere to some rules for dogs in the hotel:

1. Please use your own food bowl, not hotel dishes. Feeding should take place in the room or on the balcony. **Pets are not allowed in the restaurant.** We have a separate area just outside the restaurant with 3 tables where dogs are allowed.
2. Your loyal companion should have its own spot where it can find peace and rest. Please keep the hotel bed, seating furniture, and woolen blankets free from animals. If needed, we are happy to provide separate woolen blankets. Please contact the reception and/or floor staff for assistance.
3. Because all dogs, no matter how well-behaved, defend their territory as their own realm, please agree on specific times when your dog is not in the room to allow for undisturbed cleaning.
4. Many rare animals and plants live around Bad Hindelang. We owe this to the landowners who manage this area very carefully through forestry, hunting, and especially agriculture. Apart from hygienic problems on pastures – soiled feed is not gladly eaten – dog feces in the green fodder poses health risks to the cattle.
5. Please take your dog outside the hotel grounds for walks. Where the municipality has set up "Roby-dog-WCs," we kindly ask you to use them along with the corresponding bags. Dog waste bags are available free of charge at the reception or in the guest information. Absorbent pads are not allowed for use in the room. You surely understand that we can only accommodate house-trained dogs. Failure to comply may result in cleaning charges.
6. Flower beds and the lawn by the swimming pool are off-limits to dogs.

Locations of dog toilets with bag dispensers:

Bad Hindelang: In the village at the Sparkasse; at the beginning of the footpath from Jörg-Lederer-Straße to the Protestant church; at the entrance to Hirschbachwäldchen (next to the mini-golf course); at the all-weather sports field.

Bad Oberdorf: at the entrance to Schanzpark; Eisenhammerweg Wildbach bridge; Hirschbachweg chapel; directly at the entrance to our parking lot and below the hotel at the entrance to the Krolfplatz.
